Should you have other members of your family (aunts/uncle/grandparents/caregivers) who might like to receive this letter, please let me know and we can add them to the list as well.

FORMS: There are many handbook forms that were sent electronically. Please fill these out as soon as possible. Please send a note to your teacher informing them of the plans for your child at the end of the day.

MASKS: We have a variety of children size masks available for free. Please let Mrs. Dvoracek know if you would like a spare or two.

HOMEWORK HELP: We offer homework help for students in grades 2-8 every day after school until 3:45. A different teacher is available each day to supervise and to give students a quiet place to work on homework. Please encourage your child to take advantage of this wonderful opportunity. Once in homework help they will stay there until a parent picks them up or homework help ends. If they are not picked up by the end of homework help (3:45) they will be sent to our extended care and you will be billed \$3 per hour per child. Please keep in mind that homework help is truly homework help.

EXTENDED CARE: We offer extended care for all students after school until 5:30. If you would like to utilize this program, please sign up with Mrs. Baldwin. This is a very popular program and space is limited. Parents must sign up to take advantage of this service.

T-SHIRTS: We will be providing each student with a St. Mary t-shirt. These may be worn for gym class (students change into them and then back into their uniform) and can be worn on blue jean days. We are guessing at the size – please check it out and us know if you need a different size.

Jean Day: Friday, September 11 will be our first Jean Day. Students may wear jeans with a St. Mary School Shirt for a donation (monetary or food) to the Charlevoix Food Pantry.
