It ends Holy Saturday with the vigil Mass. We celebrate the resurrection Jesus on Easter Sunday. Mass times for holy week are: Palm Sunday: 4pm Saturday, April 1 and 8 and 10am on Sunday, April 2; Holy Thursday: 7pm Mass; Good Friday Stations at 2pm; Divine Mercy Novena at 2:30pm and Good Friday Service at 3pm; Holy Saturday Vigil Mass 8pm; Easter Sunday 8am and 10am.

Chrism Mass: The 6 and 7 grade students will attend the Chrism Mass in Gaylord on Tuesday, April 4 They will need to bring lunch money for Culvers. Please let Mrs. Dvoracek know if you need help with this.
